She obtained her Bachelor of Art degree in English from Bethune-Cookman College in 1965. After graduation, she made a commitment to teaching English to students in Miami, FL, Haines City, FL, Clark Air Force Base in the Phillipines, and Vogelweh, Germany. She was employed for many years at South Middle School in Aurora, CO.

Connie married her high school sweetheart, Zed M. Hampton, on February 25, 1962. They were happily committed to each other for 53 years.
