



## Ret USAF Donald Wendell Dorsey

April 5, 1930 - February 24, 2025

Donald W. Dorsey passed away on February 24, 2025, at the age of 94. Born on April 5, 1930, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, he was one of six children to Beatrice L. Dorsey and Howard E. Dorsey.

Donald attended public schools in Philadelphia before completing his high school education in California while serving in the military, earning his certificate of completion after attending evening classes. In December 1949, he enlisted in the United States Air Force, where he dedicated over 20 years of service and received numerous honors and decorations.

During his time in the Air Force, Donald met the love of his life, Marilyn Sue Ross, in Topeka, Kansas. The two married in 1952 and were blessed with three children. Together, they embraced the military lifestyle, traveling extensively and cherishing the experiences along the way.

After retiring from the Air Force in January 1970 at Nellis Air Force Base in Las Vegas, Nevada, Donald and his family settled in Denver, Colorado, where he began a second career with the United States Postal Service. He worked diligently for 20 years before retiring in 1990.

Donald had a passion for playing golf, often enjoying rounds with his postal friends. He also took great pride in crafting his own grape and elderberry wine,

reveling in compliments from friends and family about its taste.

A dedicated member of several organizations, Donald was a proud lifetime member of The Retired Enlisted Association (TREA) Chapter #3 in Aurora Colorado, an active member of the American Legion Post #087, and a participant in the Military Retiree Breakfast Bunch, where he enjoyed monthly gatherings until he was no longer able to attend. In 1993, he joined Shorter AME Church, where he remained a devoted member for many years.

Donald is survived by his three children, Tekoa, Michael, and Phillip, as well as his grandchildren and great-grandchildren, who will carry on his legacy. He will be remembered for his service, dedication to his family, sense of humor, and the joy he found in life's simple pleasures. His memory will be cherished by those who knew and loved him.

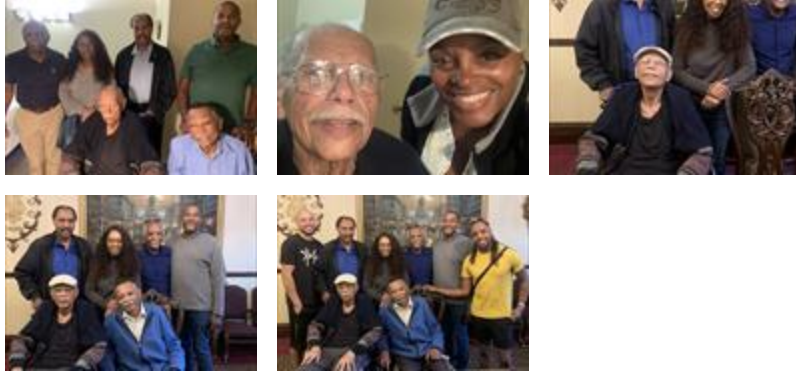
