### OBITUARY

Motor Vehicle Service Department. He recently celebrated 23-years of service. He was known by all at the post office as “Q” and as a very dedicated worker, even when he wasn’t in the best of physical health.

Quincy enjoyed watching his Denver Broncos on Sundays and looked forward to smack talking with his postal co-workers. He was truly a die-hard fan that bled orange and blue! He would candidly admit, shopping was his addiction; owning over 100 pairs of tennis shoes, over 50 pairs of Stacey Adams, and too many suits in every color to count. He also loved traveling, going to concerts, listening to old school music, the company of his wife and grandchildren, and having long conversations with family and friends over the phone.

Amen was a dedicated son, husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, family member, and friend until he was called home on August 30, 2018.
