



Tanya Marie Dobbins (Private Arrangements)

March 1, 1964 - August 22, 2020

Tanya Marie Dobbins, 56, was born March 1, 1964 in San Francisco, CA. She was raised by her grandmother, godparents and a tribe of family members that instilled strong values related to education and community. She loved to read, participate in community clubs, and play basketball as a child. She read the Bible regularly. Tanya was in Who's Who and graduated from Carver High School with Honors and went to the Navy. After being honorably discharged she graduated with honors from Lawson State College and moved to Denver, CO to help her mother and stepfather raise children. Tanya admired her Uncle Frank Hutchins, who preceded her in death, and followed in his footsteps of landing her dream job as a Denver Deputy Sheriff. When she joined the department, she wanted to help the community, so she joined the Black Sheriff Protective Association where she became the first female president, provided college scholarships, participated in community food drives, assisting the elderly, and mentoring young people. She always said, "We'll get it done." During her 20-year tenure with the department, she obtained her bachelor's degree, promoted to Sergeant, and served on various panels and community groups to bring equity in law enforcement considering the LGBTQ community and people of color. In her personal time, Tanya would take gift cards to school lunch personnel just to say, "Thank you for your service." She was a prominent member of the community and a devoted family member. Without a doubt she was the change she wanted to see in this world. After 17 days in the ICU from the impacts of a brain aneurysm, on August 22, 2020 she

passed away. Those left to cherish Tanya's memory include Mother Mary R. Luten, Father Alfred G. Moody who preceded her in death, Stepfather George Luten, Spouse Samaria Sullivan, Sister Francine Dobbins, Her four nieces and nephews, and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins, grand nieces and nephews, and many friends. We are deeply saddened by Tanya's loss. She touched so many lives and will be greatly missed.
